

Procedures for Establishing an Estate Provision Benefiting the Literacy Research Association

Thank you for your interest in including the Literacy Research Association (LRA) in your estate plans. To begin this process, please email VJ Mayor, Executive Director (VJMayor@asginfo.net), to identify and develop bequest language for your desired gift. Bequest language may name a specific existing or new fund of LRA, depending on the intent of your gift. A Gift Agreement will be created by the Executive Director using the suggested language and will be sent to you for approval. The Gift Agreement should be executed before your will or revocable trust because the date of the Agreement is inserted in the bequest provision. Your attorney can proceed with the suggested language provided by the Executive Director once the Gift Agreement is signed.

A sample suggested provision referencing a Gift Agreement with LRA would be:
